I have it on good authority that spiritual is better than natural. Jesus said, "*It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing. The words that I speak to you are spirit, and they are life*" (John 6:63).

"Natural" includes flesh. It is material. You can't see "spiritual," though its existence is self-evident. You are a spirit-person within a natural body. God is a spirit, too. Some believe that the word "spirit" is just a figurative term to describe a physical being, namely man—who is their specimen. They have discovered ever-reducing, tinier fractions of the "natural" man. They diminish him and his behavior to smaller and smaller physical units and so attempt to explain him. In doing this, they fail to find anything "spiritual" in their specimen. If their specimen believes in God, then they seek to explain God through what they know about their specimen. Give them any complex natural system, and they conclude its origin was natural and seek to describe it that way. That's because they are swallowed up in the "natural."

The "natural" is the only way they will allow the Creation to be explained. They are like a blind man who doesn't believe in light because he has never seen it. These "natural" people have and will make tremendous physical and materialistic progress. Advancement in medicine, I-pods, and microwaves are largely their achievements. I don't mean this sarcastically; it's truly representative of how much—and in what way—they have made man happier. These achievements are not necessarily wrong and they may be good. In this way, they have made men "better," but they are limited to the natural, since they refuse to consider the spiritual. The Bible says, "*The natural man does not receive the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; nor can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned*" (1 Corinthians 2:14).

If you take a pig to a concert of great music, it won't help him appreciate what you may value out of that experience. If you take a beautiful, noble, high-stepping horse, you still won't affect the animal. Both lack the capability of music appreciation, though one is more pleasant than the other. An immoral pig of a man can't appreciate God's gifts. But it won't help if he is a noble genius of a man either—if he won't acknowledge God. They have more in common with each other than they do the believer. They are natural; he is spiritual.

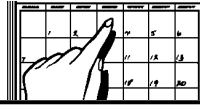

## Telephone Scam

The latest scam involves a phone call that informs you that a relative has been injured or arrested, an unpaid account must be settled, or a cash prize can be claimed, etc. and asks you to call a phone number with one of the following area codes: 809, 284, or 876. These codes are international and can be set up to bill your phone number at a high rate and include additional "special" fees. The scam works because, although these area codes are outside the U.S., (Dominican Republic, British Virgin Islands, and Jamaica) they can be dialed directly without the usual "011" international prefix. Since these locations aren't subject to U.S. laws, there is no legal requirement to inform you of the high rates and special fees.

AT&T advises consumers to always check the location of unfamiliar area codes before dialing. This can be done at **www.consumer.att.com** or simply Google the area code (e.g., "area code 809") and view the top result.
