Once I heard a story about a little girl who looked at the picture, then asked her mother, "Did He ever make it in there?" That's a good question - one you must ask yourself. Is He living in me?

## Crossword Puzzle

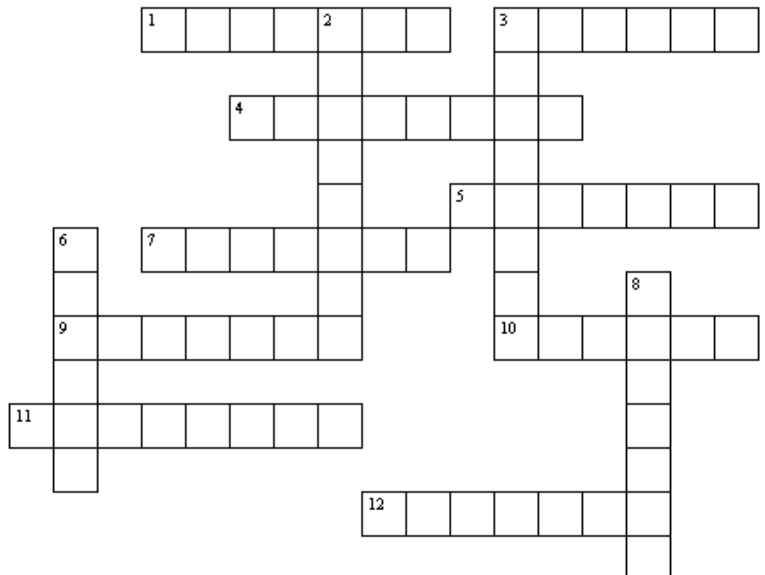
