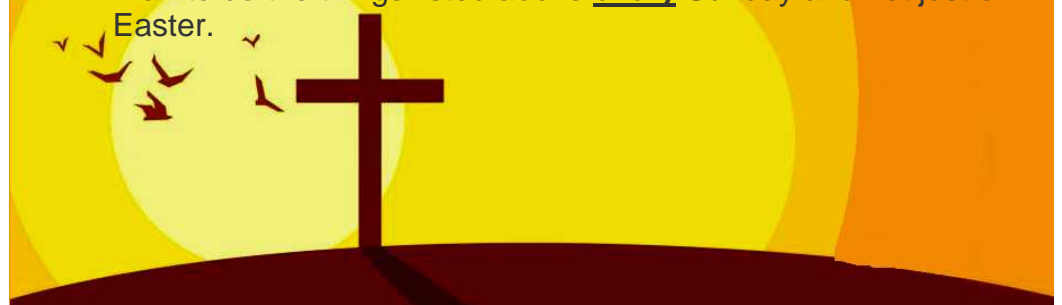

Easter Sunday Coming
