Do you do that "something more"? Expect more of yourself and you will do more.

## Directory Available

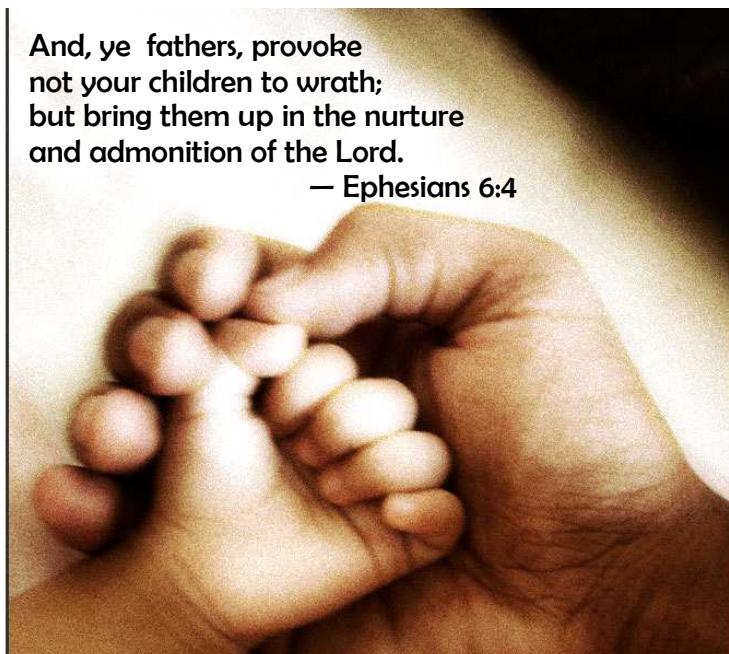
