## **A Letter From Steve Miller**

Dear Church,

I have prayed for this day—the Sunday when I would feel well enough to once again preach God's word. I honor Him for having answered that prayer!

Here is an update. The doctor discovered a fifth spinal compression fracture last week on the bone scan, along with several rib fractures. I have lost two inches in height from the fractures, and 25 pounds from lack of appetite. I am on meds and supplements to begin to stabilize and reverse the osteoporosis. The root cause appears to be low testosterone and vitamin D levels. An endocrinologist is doing extensive blood tests to pinpoint and rectify the cause. We'll get the results in a couple of weeks. I praise God that we caught this before more damage was done.

The good news is that I am now able to walk for short periods of time without a walker. My pain has decreased and my strength is increasing daily in small increments. The doctor thinks I'll have normal work capacity in as little as three months. Unfortunately, even though I am able to come today, I have to be extremely careful of contracting colds and infections. Hugs are not something I can enjoy right now.

In my home are dozens of get-well cards and letters. I have a stack of encouraging books you have given me. I have enjoyed videos you have sent, and food you have brought. I've cherished the pictures of your children you've mailed. I have been strengthened through this long winter by the knowledge that my church family was praying for me. I have admired your dedication and strength as you have shouldered jobs and responsibilities that were mine. I have appreciated the lessons preached by the men who filled the pulpit when I was helpless to do so.

I have been completely humbled by your outpouring of love, faith, patience and support.

If I were to try to tell you from the pulpit today how much you mean to me, I'm afraid I would break down completely. There will come a day when I can talk about what I have learned during this dark time—but that will have to come later. I simply can't do that yet. I give thanks to God for every one of you,

## Pictorial Directory Update

It is time for us to update our pictorial directory. We need your cooperation in order to get all of the information and pictures together. Here is what we are asking everyone to do:

1. A rough copy of the new pictorial directory has been laid out on the table in the foyer. Check the rough directory to see if you have a page there. If you do, check the information to see if it is current. If you have no picture or would like a new picture, see Stephanie Copas or Gary Glispie right away. They will make the picture before or after any service—just a matter of a few seconds.

2. **If you do not have a page in the current directory**, check the typed version of the directory laying out on the table for your name.

**"Old Pic"** means we have put your old directory picture in the rough copy (which is fine if you are happy with it, but you may want to update the picture).

**"Old Info"** means we have a new picture but the information may need to be updated.

**"No Pic"** means we need a picture.

**"Need New Pic and Info"** probably means you have gotten married or had a baby or something so we need a new picture and new information.

3. **If new information is needed**, fill out one of the information sheets on the table and when you have completed it, put it on the bottom of the pile of blank sheets.

4. **If a new picture is needed**, get with Gary Glispie or Stephanie Copas before or after services and get your new picture made ASAP.

Gary will be standing close to the table after services to answer any questions you may have about the process.
