was pleased that Solomon asked him for wisdom, so he granted him riches and honor in addition to wisdom. A wise man would be able to handle riches and honor.

"Make your ear attentive to wisdom ... If you seek her as silver And search for her as for hidden treasures ... Then you will discern righteousness and justice And equity and every good course. For wisdom will enter your heart And knowledge will be pleasant to your soul; Discretion will guard you, Understanding will watch over you (Prov 2:2-11)."

It is not wealth, power, or any other such thing that watches over us. It is the wisdom which comes from God. How can you obtain wisdom? You must search for it as hidden treasure. It is within our reach yet elusive.

"The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, And the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding. (Prov 9:10)."

He tells us where to begin. You must begin with God. That is why Solomon asked God for wisdom. When do you know you finally have obtained wisdom. You don't. Indeed, the pursuit of wisdom is a life-long journey that never ends. That is why he tells us to search diligently for it like hidden treasure.

If you could wish for one thing, what would you wish for?

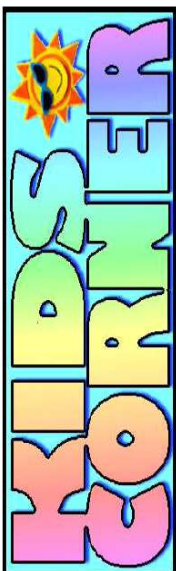
