Thoughts on Hebrews

We previously studied the book of Hebrews in an adult Bible class. Although the original audience of the book was Hebrew Christians that were feeling a bit shaky and wavering in the faith. They had started to question just why it was that they had chosen to follow Jesus.

We find ourselves in the same place at times. Sometimes feeling a bit shaky, a bit weak, doubtful, and not really too engaged in worship. Why is that? Could it be that we are filling ourselves with things of this world rather than with God's word?

In the gospels, Jesus, when tempted by the devil, said that a man can't live on bread alone, but he needs every word that comes from God. We know that bread will allow our body's to survive, but can we truly live?

One of the many things that Hebrews tells us is that we should be busy finding ways to encourage one another, to motivate each other to become engaged in worshipping the Father.

Hebrews 10:19-23 Be confident in Jesus.
