## As the LORD Commanded

***The LORD said to Moses, “Bring Aaron and his sons, their garments, the anointing oil, the bull for the sin offering, the two rams and the basket containing bread made without yeast, and gather the entire assembly at the entrance to the tent of meeting.” Moses did as the LORD commanded him, and the assembly gathered at the entrance to the tent of meeting. Leviticus 8:1-4***

In Exodus chapters 25 – 31, God gave Moses specific instructions on how to build the tabernacle, construct the furniture, consecrate the priests, and most importantly how to worship Him. In Leviticus, we are told that Moses did each of these “as the LORD commanded him”. The Israelites were instructed exactly how they were to live their lives and worship God.

There was no ambiguity and Moses did exactly as he was commanded. Our God is a loving God, but He also created us and knows what He wants us to do. The New Testament is also full of instructions on how we are to live our lives and how we are to worship Him.

Do we read and follow those instructions?

How many times have you purchased some new device and immediately started trying to put it together and use it without looking at the instructions? I know I have. God made us and He wrote the instruction book for us to follow.

When we first start using some device and then we look in the instruction manual and say, “Why should I do it that way?”, we are expressing the same sentiment as when we read the Bible and say, “Why does God care that I worship that way?”. God is the creator of the universe, and He is the creator of our lives. He knows us better than we know ourselves. There is a purpose in His plan. The question is, do we look at and follow that plan or do we try to do it our way? Both the Old and New Testament tell us that we are to, “***Love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength.***”

Deuteronomy 6:5, Mark 12:30. If we want to ask why, it is because God made us, and He wrote the “instruction manual” on how we are to live, worship, and seek Him. Moses decided to follow God’s instructions exactly and to teach those commands to the Israelites. Will we do the same? As Christians, how do we look at our lives and see ourselves?

*“After this, Paul left Athens and went to Corinth. There he met a Jew named Aquila, a native of Pontus, who had recently come from Italy with his wife Priscilla, because Claudius had ordered all Jews to leave Rome. Paul went to see them, and because he was a tentmaker as they were, he stayed and worked with them.” Acts 18:1-3.*

If we were in Corinth and we asked Paul who he was, would he say, “I am a tentmaker and a Christian” or would he say, “I am a Christian and a tentmaker”? How do you think he viewed his life? I am confident Paul would have said, “I am a Christian and a tentmaker”. Why does this matter? Paul had completely dedicated his whole life to Christ and the church. His first priority was always to Christ and the church. This should also be our goal for our lives. It requires a change in our way of thinking from the world’s view, and growing in our view of God and the church. In the church today, many would identify themselves by their jobs, hobbies, and other activities and roles first, then as Christians. Who do you put first in your life?
