The Context of the Command

"My children, I will be with you only a little longer. You will look for me, and just as I told the Jews, so I tell you now: Where I am going, you cannot come." "A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another." John 13:33-35 NIV

Everything that Jesus did in this world was motivated by and displayed the love that is an essential part of the nature of God. He was kind and considerate to everyone who came to Him truly seeking help. Even His rebukes of those who opposed the truth were based on His love for them and for others. When Jesus saw people in need, He responded, not simply to demonstrate His power and rightful claim to be the Messiah, but because of His love for them. "But when he saw the multitudes, he was moved with compassion on them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd" (Matthew 9:36).

It was when Jesus was preparing the disciples for His death and return to Heaven, the night before the crucifixion, that He issued the new commandment. He would soon not be physically present to express God's love. Instead His followers would need to take up that cause. And Jesus said the love of His followers for each other would be a convincing evidence that they are truly following Him. Nothing substitutes for love. Many bitter disputes and divides have arisen, not primarily because of doctrinal problems, but because of heart problems. We are constantly tempted to let our religious observance take the place of the love we are commanded to show to those around us.
