Living Like Jesus

This is how we know what love is: Jesus Christ laid down his life for us. And we ought to lay down our lives for our brothers and sisters.

1 John 3:16 NIV

Evidence of God's goodness and glory are all around us. David wrote, **"The heavens declare the glory of God; The skies proclaim the work of his hands. Day after day they pour forth speech; Night after night they reveal knowledge. They have no speech, they use no words; no sound is heard from them. Yet their voice goes out into all the earth, their words to the ends of the world"** (Psalm 19:1-4). No one is able to truthfully deny the existence of God. They may claim He does not exist. They may claim the Bible to be an ancient and unreliable collection of fables and myths. They may refuse to accept the truth, But the truth does not change. God is revealed to the world through His creation.

Even more specifically, God's love is revealed to the world through the life, death, and resurrection of His Son. Again this message is unmistakable because Jesus did not die for His friends or for those who were worthy of His sacrifice, which some people might have done. Instead Jesus died for His enemies, showing His love to the very people who killed Him as well as to each of us a sinners. **"For scarcely for a righteous man will one die: yet peradventure for a good man some would even dare to die.**

But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us" (Romans 5:7-8). Although God's love is revealed in creation, it is perceived in the sacrificial death of Jesus.
