Self Deception

The heart is deceitful above all things and beyond cure. Who can understand it? "I the Lord search the heart and examine the mind, to reward the mind, to reward each person according to their conduct, according to what their deeds deserve." Jeremiah 17:9-10 NIV

There are some people who became famous in large measure because of their capacity to deceive others into thinking they were something they were not. We see this in the Bible where Judas was selected by the other disciples to handle their money. None of them realized he was a thief, or they certainly would never have trusted him with that responsibility. The name Benedict Arnold remains synonymous with treason nearly 250 years after his betrayal, but when he was entrusted with command of the fort at West Point, New York, that guarded the vital Hudson River access to the city, his colleagues and superiors thought he was loyal to the cause of American independence.

But the deceit of others pales in comparison to the deceit we are able to practice on ourselves. It is easy for us to convince ourselves that we are doing much better than we are—that we are strong spiritually and that we are worthy of the praise of others. We find the lies we tell ourselves easy to believe because we want them to be true. James wrote, "But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves" (James 1:22). We must constantly be on guard, because Satan uses our deceptive hearts against us. This is not just a problem other people have—it is our problem. The English Puritan Richard Baxter wrote, "Self is the most treacherous enemy, and the most insinuating deceiver in the world. Of all other vices, it is both the hardest to find out, and the hardest to cure." The best way to guard against being led astray by our hearts is to rely on the truth of God's Word and respond to the conviction of the Holy Spirit.

Christian Mothers With Young Children Don't Give Up

Sometimes the only worship experience I have on Sunday morning is the short prayer I utter as we enter the church building: "Lord, please let little Charlie be decent today and Bro. Banks' sermon be short." Charlie is my two year old wiggleworm who has known from birth that the excellent acoustics in the church building were created just for him. He automatically becomes all arms and legs as we enter the doors, and delights in wrapping them around me at the worst possible times. The song books become a challenge to tame and pencils becomes weapons to duck.

So, Do I ask myself if it's worth it? Sometimes I do. But I know that training up a child in the way he should go is a seven-day-a week job, Not just an at home Monday-Saturday responsibility. Sleeping on Sunday morning through Bible class and worship service might be a temptation if we didn't consider 'our Charlie' a very special gift straight from God. This gift is also a bundle of responsibilities for us. I know that the things we do now will affect what he does on Sundays at worship time twenty years from now, when he's making his own decisions.

So, we keep on going, knowing someday there is a Sunday coming when Charlie is going to sit quietly through the whole service. It's through patience and discipline we watch our children grow. We prayerfully hope to see him grow to be a Christian man, strong and faithful to his Lord.
