What does God expect from Us?

As Jesus was walking beside the Sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers, Simon called Peter and his brother Andrew. They were casting a net into the lake, for they were fishermen. "Come, follow me," Jesus said, "and I will send you out to fish for people." At once they left their nets and followed him. Going on from there, he saw two other brothers, James son of Zebedee and his brother John. They were in a boat with their father Zebedee, preparing their nets. Jesus called them, and immediately they left the boat and their father and followed him. Matthew 4:18-22 NIV

What does God expect when we become a follower of Jesus? When Jesus called His disciples, they left everything; their nets, home, family, profession, and past life and went with Jesus. When Jesus saw the crowd around him, he gave orders to cross to the other side of the lake. Then a teacher of the law came to him and said, "Teacher, I will follow you wherever you go." Jesus replied, "Foxes have dens and birds have nests, but the Son of Man has no place to lay his head." Another disciple said to him, "Lord, first let me go and bury my father." But Jesus told him, "Follow me, and let the dead bury their own dead." Matthew 8:18-22 This passage seems to express a similar idea, emphasizing the priorities of following Jesus. The teacher of the law was told that if he follows, he will not have a place to sleep at night. We look at these passages and make excuses why we can't live like that. What was Jesus REALLY saying in this teaching? Let's look at the very next verses. Then he got into the boat and his disciples followed him. Suddenly a furious storm came up on the lake, so that the waves swept over the boat. But Jesus was sleeping. The disciples went and woke him, saying, "Lord, save us! We're going to drown!" He replied, "You of little faith, why are you so afraid?" Then he got up and rebuked the winds and the waves, and it was completely calm. The men were amazed and asked, "What kind of man is this? Even the winds and the waves obey him!" Matthew 8:23-27.

Jesus had said he had no place to lay his head, but he was sleeping on the boat, during a "furious storm". The storm became so bad that the disciples, some of whom were fishermen and made their living on the lake, were afraid of drowning. He accused them of having "little faith". At that point Jesus commanded the storm to stop and it did.

Jesus was telling the people that to follow Him, they had to give up trusting in themselves, their possessions, and their previous thinking about what it means to follow God.

How did the early followers of Jesus use their talents and possessions? Paul was a tentmaker and sometimes used that profession to support himself when he was travelling and spreading the Word (Acts 18:3). Luke was a physician but spent a lot of time documenting the life of Christ and the Church so that others might believe. Martha had a home and opened it to Jesus and His disciples (Luke 10:38). The intent is not to necessarily dispose of everything we have and everything we are, but to use them to live our faith. Hearing that Jesus had silenced the Sadducees, the Pharisees got together. One of them, an expert in the law, tested him with this question: "Teacher, which is the greatest commandment in the Law?" Jesus replied: "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.'

All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments." Matthew 22:34-40

Jesus wanted His disciples to dedicate themselves wholly to the work that was ahead. Jesus expected them to "love God with all their heart, soul, mind and strength". So, what was Jesus asking the people He called to do? Jesus was asking them to TRUST Him completely with their lives.

Every one of us can trust Jesus.

When we do that, then Jesus will work in our lives to do great things for the Kingdom of God.
