The Joy of the Lord is My Strength

Then Nehemiah the governor, Ezra the priest and teacher of the Law, and the Levites who were instructing the people said to them all, "This day is holy to the LORD your God. Do not mourn or weep." For all the people had been weeping as they listened to the words of the Law. Nehemiah said, "Go and enjoy choice food and sweet drinks, and send some to those who have nothing prepared. This day is holy to our Lord. Do not grieve, for the joy of the LORD is your strength."

Nehemiah 8:9-10

I have been singing the song "The Joy of the Lord" in my head for the last several days. In looking through the Bible references, Nehemiah 8 is the only place where this phrase appears.

In this portion of Nehemiah, some of the Israelites had come back to Jerusalem after their exile in Babylon. They had rebuilt the walls and restored some of the houses. The people gathered on the first day of the 7th month to hear the Book of the Law read. The Levites translated and explained the scriptures so that all could understand what God wanted. The people were mourning and weeping because they had failed to keep the Law of God. At that point, Nehemiah told them not to grieve because "the joy of the Lord is your strength". Why did he say that? The people had sinned. They had not followed the Law of God. How could they have joy?

First, we need to decide what JOY is. I do NOT believe that it is the same as happiness. James says, "Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds, because you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance." James 1:1-2.

Most people would NOT be "happy" with trials and testing. The people who were <u>doing</u> the testing were the Jewish leaders who were persecuting the Christians. The people who were <u>being</u> tested were the devoted followers of Christ. Those who <u>persevered</u> the testing were the Christians who had a strong faith that they did not let go of. The joy comes from the <u>assurance</u> that <u>all</u> is right between you and God.

In Nehemiah 8:10, the people were responding with mourning when they realized that they had not fully followed God's law. That feeling of grief is the first step toward repentance and renewal of your relationship with God. The people were showing their faith and trust in God. Nehemiah was telling them that when they have that relationship with God, they can be assured that all is right between them and God.
