The Providence of God

So do not worry, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?' For the pagans run after all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them. But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well. Matthew 6:31-33

One of the big words that we hear when discussing the characteristics of our God is providence. The meaning of providence is God guiding all things toward His predetermined goals to His glory. In the passage above, Jesus says that God knows what we need and when we seek Him, the other things that we need will be given to us. The question is, do we really believe that? When we look at our life and the blessings we have been given, do we believe they came from God, or do we believe that we worked and got all those things by our own efforts. When something good happens in our life, do we believe that God gave it or do we say, "That was good luck!"? Do we even think to stop and acknowledge or thank God for it? When God brought Israel out of Egypt, he sent them to the promised land. When Israel decided that they could not trust God to deliver the land to them, God sent them to wander in the dessert for 40 years. During that time, God provided all the needs of the people. He provided guidance, water, food, and clothes that did not wear out. He was teaching them to depend on Him and that he could meet all their needs. Now listen, you who say, "Today or tomorrow we will go to this or that city, spend a year there, carry on business and make money." Why, you do not even know what will happen tomorrow. What is your life? You are a mist that appears for a little while and then vanishes. Instead, you ought to say,

"If it is the Lord's will, we will live and do this or that." James 4:13-15 When we think about how God cares for us, we also need to believe that God is in control of this world. We have choices to make but God directs how those choices will turn out. If we decide to take a trip, then instead we get sick and reschedule the trip, do we think that it was just bad luck, or do we believe that God has something better in store for us with the change in plan. God loves us and wants the best for us. In fact, The LORD himself goes before you and will be with you; he will never leave you nor forsake you. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged. Deuteronomy 31:8.
