Why We Need to Pray

Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you: For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened. Or what man is there of you, whom if his son ask bread, will he give him a stone? Or if he ask a fish, will he give him a serpent? If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children, how much more shall your Father which is in heaven give good things to them that ask him? Matthew 7:7-11 KJV

Our prayers don't give God new information. He does not need to discover what we need—He already knows. God knows not only what we need, but also how and when He will provide it, or what He will do instead if our requests would not be for our best. God could easily answer every prayer immediately, He often does not. There are times when we pray for days or weeks or even years before the answer comes. In these cases, we can always trust that God has our best interests at heart. When Jesus laid out the pattern for prayer, He talked about it not as a one time thing but rather a continuing action. When we keep on asking, keep on seeking, and keep on knocking, we can expect God to answer just as He promised. God wants us to have a close and personal relationship with Him. Continued and persistent prayer helps build that relationship, and it reminds us that we are completely and totally dependent on Him.
