More Than Knowledge

But thou, Bethlehem Ephratah, though thou be little among the thousands of Judah, yet out of thee shall he come forth unto me that is to be ruler in Israel; whose goings forth have been from of old, from everlasting. Therefore will he give them up, until the time that she which travaileth hath brought forth: then the remnant of his brethren shall return unto the children of Israel. And he shall stand and feed in the strength of the LORD, in the majesty of the name of the LORD his God; and they shall abide: for now shall he be great unto the ends of the earth. Micah 5:2-4 KJV

Jesus was born at a time when Israel was an unwilling part of the Roman Empire. The Jewish people knew that a Messiah had been promised. For the most part, the Jews were looking for Messiah who would lead a military revolt to restore Israel's independence. Others had made accommodations with their conquerors to become part of the power structure. The last thing they wanted to do was to rock the boat.

All of the Jews knew where Jesus would be born, according to the prophecy in Micah 5:2. We know this, because when Herod asked, they replied without hesitation. "And they said unto him, In Bethlehem of Judaea: for thus it is written by the prophet" (Matthew 2:5). But even though they knew the truth, they had no interest in going to Bethlehem themselves to see Jesus.

There was a gap between their knowledge and actions.
