#### Our Omnipotent God

Then Job replied to the LORD: "I know that you can do all things; no purpose of yours can be thwarted. You asked, 'Who is this that obscures my plans without knowledge?' Surely I spoke of things I did not understand, things too wonderful for me to know. "You said, 'Listen now, and I will speak; I will question you, and you shall answer me.' My ears had heard of you but now my eyes have seen you. Therefore I despise myself and repent in dust and ashes."

Omnipotent is a word used when people refer to the power of God. It means "having ALL power". We have trouble as humans understanding the idea of limitless anything. On earth, everything we know has limits. When we think about unlimited power, we just don't know how to visualize it.

At the end of the book of Job, he was humbled by his encounter with God. Job had suffered much at the hand of Satan and had stayed faithful to God. However, even Job got to the point that he was questioning why so many bad things were happening to him and why God did not hear him. When God spoke to him and called him to account, Job realized the vast power of the omnipotent God.

For since the creation of the world God's invisible qualities his eternal power and divine nature—have been clearly seen, being understood from what has been made, so that people are without excuse. For although they knew God, they neither glorified him as God nor gave thanks to him, but their thinking became futile and their foolish hearts were darkened.

Romans 1:20-21

When we try to understand the power of God, Paul suggests that we look around us. Everything that we know about that is powerful was made by God. Hurricanes, tornadoes, earthquakes, lighting storms, and the sun itself were all created by God. To create something, you have to have more power than what you create.
