In 1659, the Massachusetts Bay Colony passed a law called Penalty for Keeping Christmas. The Puritans viewed observing Christmas as dishonoring God. Anyone who took the day off or celebrated in a public way with a feast was to be fined five shillings. Charles Dickens' Ebenezer Scrooge famously declared, "If I could work my will, every idiot who goes about with 'Merry Christmas' on his lips should be boiled with his own pudding, and buried with a stake of holly through his heart." But Christmas is worthy of celebrating as long as we keep Jesus at the center of all we do and focus on celebrating His coming to Earth. Christ's birth in Bethlehem was the amazing expression of God's love for us and His grace to come to be our Savior.

Corrie ten Boom wrote, "Who can add to Christmas? The perfect motive is that God so loved the world. The perfect gift is that He gave His only Son.
