Our Omnipresent God

Before a word is on my tongue you, LORD, know it completely. You hem me in behind and before, and you lay your hand upon me. Such knowledge is too wonderful for me, too lofty for me to attain. Where can I go from your Spirit? Where can I flee from your presence? If I go up to the heavens, you are there; if I make my bed in the depths, you are there. If I rise on the wings of the dawn, if I settle on the far side of the sea, even there your hand will guide me, your right hand will hold me fast. Psalms 139:4-10

A popular topic in self-help circles today is "being present". It doesn't mean that you need to be physically present; but that your mind is present, listening to and focused on the person or task at hand. We can let our minds

wander to the future or the past or some other place or task when we are stressed, tired, or bored with the current situation. When we are "present", we are at our best and able to give our all to who we are with or whatever we are working on.

One of the characteristics of God is that he is <u>omnipresent</u>. He is "present" all the time and wherever we are. The psalmist captures this thought when he states that wherever he is and wherever he goes, GOD IS THERE. That was a comfort to the psalmist, and it should be a comfort to us. Not only is God always there, but He is also focused on us and our needs.

So do not worry, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?' For the pagans run after all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them. But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well. Matthew 6:31-33

In the same way, God is <u>focused</u> on <u>every</u> person's needs in the whole world. God is not just there for us individually; he is present for all people worldwide. *From one man he made all the nations, that they should inhabit the whole earth; and he marked out their appointed times in history and the boundaries of their lands. God did this so that they would seek him and perhaps reach out for him and find him, though he is not far from any one of us.* Acts 17:26-27. And if that is not enough, He is present yesterday, today, and forever (Hebrews 13:8).
