But that was just the arrest. Angels watched as Jesus was mocked, spat upon, and beaten. Can you imagine their shock and dismay at what was happening? Can you see them gathering, getting ready for war? If an angel was sent at the request of King Hezekiah, how much more when the only begotten Son is crying out to his Father? Can you imagine them looking over at God as all of these things were happening? Were they wondering when the order would be given? This was their Lord being crucified. They had worshipped him ever since they were created.

Now, they silently wait...

But the order never came.

He was scourged... He was nailed to a cross... His body was covered in blood... He cried, "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?" But the order never came.
