After Jesus had fed the five thousand people, he immediately made his disciples get into the boat and go on ahead of him to Bethsaida, while he dismissed the crowd. After leaving them, he went up on the mountainside to pray. Later that night, the boat was in the middle of the lake, and he was alone on land. He saw the disciples straining at the oars, because the wind was against them. Shortly before dawn he went out to them, walking on the lake. He was about to pass by them, but when they saw him walking on the lake, they thought he was a ghost. They cried out, because they all saw him and were terrified.

Immediately he spoke to them and said, **“Take courage! It is I. Don’t be afraid.”** Then he climbed into the boat with them, and the wind died down. Mark 6:45-51

When the Lord Jesus sent the disciples down to the sea and He went up to the mountain, He had a bird’s-eye view. He saw the whole thing. He saw them rowing. He saw the clouds as they began to rumble and boil. He saw the sea as the waves began to rise. He saw it all, and what was He doing up there? He was praying. They may not have known that He had His eye on them, but He did. He saw them toiling and rowing. They didn’t see Him, but He saw them. He never took His eye off them, and He was interceding for them. Are you in the middle of a storm?

You can trust that just like Jesus watched over the disciples, He is watching over you.
